Your comment: Most participants found very interesting and very efficient all places visited. The majority (32 participants) have greatly appreciated the visit to the University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest and cultural objectives in Bucharest (Parliament Palace, the Romanian Athenaeum, etc.). 28 people have highlighted the farms visits, and also the Beekeeping Farm and Research Center in Tulcea. 25 people were highly appreciated farms "Agro Lombardi" and "Adam Agroland". Also, participants were satisfied with visits to

museums "Eco-Delta" and "Agriculture" from Slobozia, and the "Danube Delta Biosphere Reserve".

Your comment: All participants thanked the organizers of Romania mobility, both for the high level of professionalism, but also for the way it was organized and led the action, and for scientific, technical and cultural information received.

Analysis and conclusions

Interpretation of the evaluation results was made during a teleconference project coordinators on 24 June 2015.

- The mobility in Romania has been a success and proposed objectives were achieved.
- The Romanian students were recognized for their involvement in agricultural activities and for initiating their own businesses in this area, where they have the opportunity to apply the knowledge learned.
- The Romanian students were recognized for their contribution to translations of presentations during mobilities.
- It were highlighted important aspects of mobility carried and it was concluded that it proved to be very useful for all participants with the skills and knowledge acquired, through continuous professional training, and development of partnerships based on trust, professionalism and mutual respect.
- Each team of students, in collaboration with participating teachers have developed professional presentations that brought into focus the importance of teamwork, intercultural aspects and knowledge of English and computer skills and abilities.
- Involvement and integration of young people in teamwork, in mixed international groups, improved work of all participants resulting in well structured projects that have consistently revealed the realities of each country.
- It was emphasized also good communication between coordinators during the implementation of local tasks / sharing and updating activities throughout mobilities.
