## Levice – history and nowadays



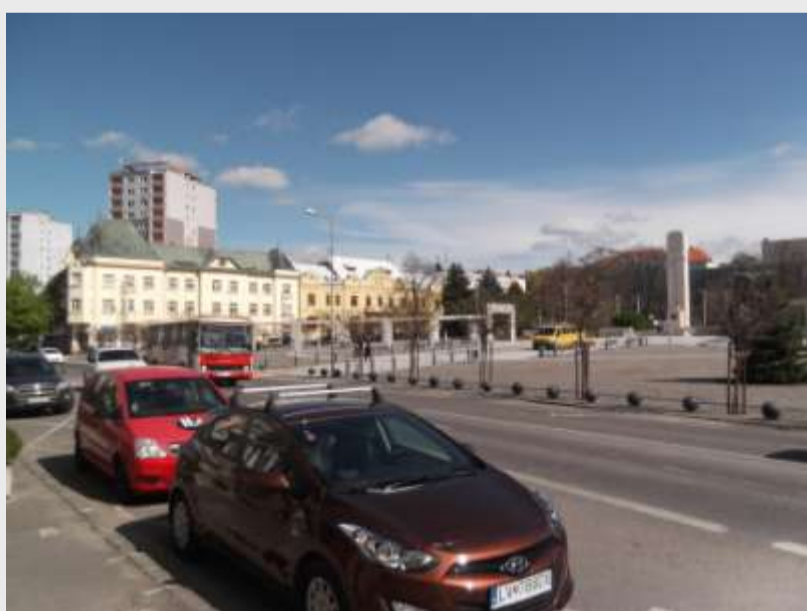
The first written evidence of its existence dates from 1156. The first reference for the castle was in 1318. For centuries the castle served as a military fortress and was particularly important during the Ottoman threat, when it protected middle-Slovakian mining towns. It was under siege for 190 years, but only taken for 9 months.



The Synagogue was built in 1853. After World War II the Jew community dissolved and vanished from Levice. The building is used for cultural acts (classical music concerts, art exhibitions etc.)



Ladislav Bielik is one of the most famous personalities from Levice thru his photos taken during the Warsaw Pact invasion in Czechoslovakia in 1968.



The restored historic center with many buildings nearly one hundred years old makes the connection between past and present. The historic center was restored using EU funding.



## Levice – history and nowadays



Levice is located in eastern part of Danubian Lowland with a population of 35000 and an area of 6100 ha.



European funds are used for reconstruction of the historical center, to create an industrial park area and restored many educational and cultural buildings. For the next years EU funding will go in infrastructure.



The Levice district, part of the Nitra region, is the largest of Slovakia's 79 districts, and it also administers the largest agro area in the country. Around 5% of the population works in agriculture.



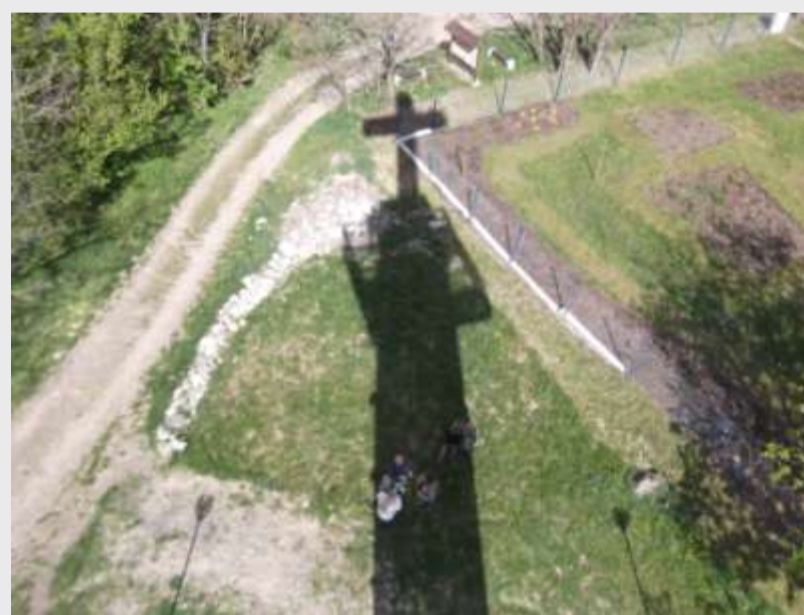
## Levice – history and nowadays
